

IMMIGRATION RESTRICTION ACT, 1901-1910.

REGULATION 12.

(1.) The Master of a vessel, other than a public vessel of a Government, arriving in the Commonwealth, from parts beyond the Commonwealth, with any passengers on board, shall, before making entry at the Customs, deliver to an officer a list of all the passengers on board, specifying, to the best of his knowledge, the name, nationality, race, place of birth, calling or occupation of each of those passengers.
